### HOT SPOT Wi-Fi LOCATION

In order to ensure that our students have access to reliable Wi-Fi, Fullerton College has recently installed upgraded hotspot technology near the 1700 Building and the Parking Structure (on Lemon and Fullerton College Dr.).

The lot is open Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. and on the weekends from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. The Wi-Fi signal is the strongest immediately west of the Field House/Building 1700.

We will be allowing students to access the campus parking lot just north of Sherbeck Field, with strict social distancing practices in place to ensure the safety of students and staff.

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### ADDS, DROPS & WITHDRAWALS

*You may log onto myGateway to add additional classes and/or drop classes from your schedule.*

**ADDING CLASSES that are closed or have started:**

1. Attend the first class meeting of the course you want to add.
2. If space is available, ask the instructor to give you an **Add Authorization Code**. Instructors may not be able to grant all requests for Add Codes.
3. Then **IMMEDIATELY** access **myGateway** Registration at [www.fullcoll.edu](http://www.fullcoll.edu).
4. Log in and click "Add or Drop Classes".
5. Select term, enter CRN, enter Add Code, pay your fees immediately.

The Add Authorization Code must be used **IMMEDIATELY** to guarantee official enrollment.

**DROPPING or WITHDRAWING from classes:**

1. Access **myGateway** Registration at [www.fullcoll.edu](http://www.fullcoll.edu).
2. Log in and click "Add or Drop Classes"
3. Select term. From the drop-down menu, choose "Drop On-Line" or "Withdrawal-Web"
4. Click "Confirm Your Choices", and then check status before exiting **myGateway**.

**myGateway** is now available 7 days a week, 24 hours a day!!!\*

Students are responsible for all other fees. Apply for CCPG online via myGateway: (1) Go to <a href="http://www.fullcoll.edu">www.fullcoll.edu</a> and click on "myGateway" and (2) Click on the Financial Aid button and follow the directions to apply for a California College Promise Grant. The CCPG is awarded for the academic year. If continuing students have a CCPG for Fall 2020, then it will be automatically awarded for Spring 2021.  The cost of attendance (COA) at Fullerton College will vary depending on the student's status of living at home with parent or living off-campus. The academic year COA for a full-time student (12 units or more) living at home with parent is estimated to be \$18,601, while the COA for a full-time student living off-campus is estimated to be \$29,469. The COA reflects full-time attendance and will be prorated based on actual enrollment.
