SUMMER 2024 CLASSES WILL BE OFFERED IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING FORMATS

- **IN-PERSON**
 - o This class is fully in-person with all class meetings on campus.
- **ONLINE**
 - o This class is fully online and does not require in-person class meetings.
- **ZOOM**
 - o This class is scheduled similar to an in-person class with set meeting times using Zoom, Canvas Conference, or other types of video conferencing during the scheduled class time.
- **HYBRID (Combined Online, ZOOM, In-Person)**
 - o This class is partially online with some required in-person class meetings on campus on specific days and times. In-person dates are listed in the schedule.

 - o This class is online with some instruction via Zoom, dates are listed in the schedule.
